Job description

To design, develop, lead and evaluate the GK sessions for the first team while meeting their physical needs through successful collaboration with the Lead Strength and Conditioning coach.

Key responsibilities

- Lead in the Delivery of technical and tactical sessions GK sessions
- Working with the analysts to provide video feedback on games, training and opposition set pieces
- Support match day preparation, organisation and warm up in line with the fixture list (as required).
- Managing the GK pathway between First Team and Under 23s
